March

Mental Health First Aid for the Suicidal Person - 1/2 day, Tues 13 March | Fee: \$55.00 inc GST | Code: MHSP1803
Learn the 3 steps to prevent suicide. Mental Health First Aid certificate is not required to complete this course.
