

problem gambling, share **your** story

If you or a family member has ever been affected by problem gambling, consider becoming a Consumer Voice Project member.

You will get accredited training, meet others affected by problem gambling, and have the chance to help tackle the issue across South Australia.

Your unique experience is valuable. By sharing your story with others you increase community awareness of the issue and spread the word on how others can seek out support.

Accredited training

Consumer Voice Project members are professionally trained by educators and counsellors. You will be supported to develop your own story about the effects of problem gambling as well as learn skills in presenting to a range of audiences and useful ways to deal with difficult questions.

You may also use this training as a module towards the Certificate IV in Community Services Work.

Your role after the training

When you have finished the training, you will be supported to share your story by speaking or presenting to a variety of audiences in a range of group settings. This could include:

- Gambling Help service sector
- Hospitality workers, gaming venues
- Community agencies
- Counselling sessions of people affected by problem gambling
- Special interest group
- Other interested community members.

You will be reimbursed for out of pocket expenses for speaking engagements.

Speaking engagements are not compulsory - you do not have to accept them once you have been trained. In fact, for some, the training in itself may be a valuable outcome.

Training details

Duration: Six weeks (consisting of a three hour session each week) and One full day

When: 6pm to 9pm on Mondays, from February 13 to March 26, 2012 (inclusive)
Full day on Saturday, March 31, 2012 (final session)
No session to be held on 12 March (Public Holiday)
